A ROOM WITH A VIEW



The Theatre Room is an art deco inspired alteration to the Georgian Mansion House that was added to the building in the 1940s. Following the 2019 refurbishment, the room is now a blank canvas event space that can be transformed to suit all tastes.

Perfect for both ceremonies and receptions, the Theatre Room comfortably holds up to 80 ceremony and wedding breakfast guests and offers additional capacity for evening receptions. In a nod to its past life as an open air theatre, a design feature of the Theatre Room is the line of bi-folding doors that offer uninterrupted views out to the secret garden and private terrace at the rear of the House.





BRINGING THE OUTSIDE IN

For larger parties in need of additional space, slide back the bi-folding doors of the Theatre Room and take the sweeping staircase out into the Mansion House's secret garden.

The terrace can be set up with outdoor furniture and there's also room for a marquee in the beautifully secluded area if you're looking to give your guests an extra wow factor.

In the secret garden, guests can take in the beauty of the parkland as they sip a welcome drink or meander along the path to the glass enclosure where the Neolithic Calder Stones, which give the local area its name, are housed.

As old as Stonehenge, the 5,000 year-old Calder Stones are one of the UK's most significant ancient monuments and offer a unique backdrop to your celebration.

SAMPLE MENU

CANAPÉS

Chicken katsu skewers / Bruschetta topped with basil, shallotts and cherry tomatoes / Halloumi dippers with honey and orange dressing / Crispy potato nest with bacon and cheddar /Mini Thai crab cakes with chili dip

STARTERS

Feta and spinach bruschetta (v) Pâté with crusty bread and homemade chutney Leek and potato soup (ve)(gf) Salmon and horseradish toasts

MAINS

Tender chicken breast stuffed with sun-dried tomatoes, mozzarella and spinach, with baby tomatoes on the vine, asparagus and dauphinoise potatoes

Slow cooked chicken breast or beef accompanied by roast potatoes, parsnips, baby carrots, stuffing, Yorkshire puddings, cheesy cauliflower and gravy

Balti Pie or butternut squash topped with Mediterranean vegetables and breadcrumbs, accompanied by roast potatoes, parsnips, baby carrots, stuffing, Yorkshire puddings and vegan gravy (ve)
